Art Competition Rules

Exhibition: Artists' work will show on the November 3rd at 9 a.m. until 4 p.m. at the Hotel Alice above Bosun Joe's Restaurant, located at 110 Front Street, Ellisville, MS 39437. Art Piece for the competition must be checked in at the following schools to the following representatives by **October 26, 2018:**

Moselle: Belinda Beech

South Jones High School: Ashley Purvis

South Jones Elementary: Chelsa Johnson

Jones College: Mark Brown

Prizes: 4 First Place Winners will receive a basket of gift cards and goodies, depending on age category. First Place Winners also receive a featured showing together at Jones College Fine Arts Building. Second and Third Place Winners will receive a ribbon to give recognition to their art work.

Eligibility: Everyone and anyone who is a student at the following schools (Moselle, South Jones Elementary, South Jones High, and Jones College) are encouraged to participate and enter into the contest. Painting and drawing media will only be accepted for the show this year.

Deadline: All artwork must be submitted with a completed registration form and entry fee of **\$3.00 made payable in Cash or Check written to the Ellis Club** by October 26th to the corresponding representative at each school.

Copyright and Reproduction: All works entered for the competition must be original. By submitting artwork entries to the competition, participants grant the Ellis Fest Art Competition Committee the right to exhibit entries submitted. The Ellis Fest Committee will use photos for promotional purposes.

Judging: A committee of judges will select the winners based on originality, clarity, quality of execution, and relevance. Judging will happen prior to the exhibition. We ask all artists to refrain from attendance during the judging. Winners' ribbons will be exhibited the day of the festival.

Loss, Damage, and Return of Art: All entries will be returned to the artist the day of the exhibition in the same shape artwork arrived in. If there are reasons that cannot permit the artist to take their piece the afternoon of the exhibition, the last day artists will have to collect their artwork will be Tuesday, November 6th at 3 PM. After that, the Ellis Fest Art Committee will not be responsible for the artwork.
